

My Life in Dolpo



Semduk Lama, the current school manager of the Tapriza Schule in Dolpo, tells us in photographs about his youth in Dolpo, where he worked as a goatherd and yak caravan guide, later earned his livelihood as a trader and trekking guide until he achieved his current position as the head of the Tapriza School. He reports of the manifold challenges of a school manager, of the times with the Maoists, the wild gold rush mood in search of the caterpillar-mushroom Yartsa Gunbu und the consequences of the earthquake of 2015.
